Applicants must achieve 65% in the TEG B1 Exam Irish to be eligible to apply for full-time PME Primary Course.

Places on the course are given based on Interview performance – Interview Criteria

Up to 10 additional marks may be awarded for students who successfully complete the TEG oral examination at a high level and these marks will be added to their interview score.

Candidates who have passed higher levels of TEG (B2, C1 and C2) receive 10 additional marks providing the level was passed prior to the PME closing date.

Interview – purpose of interview is to ascertain your suitability for the course of training as a primary teacher. Assess your strengths and be prepared to give evidence that you have a genuine interest in teaching. It is not enough to say that you have always wanted to teach. Voluntary work with young people and some time spent in classroom observation in one or more primary schools are important.
